Could you please urgently fax me the name and phone number of your solicitor appointed to submit probate to Greece?

It is only 5 weeks to our mother's death anniversary.

I grieve very much for the loss of your daughter too but I still have a duty to perform with regard to my own family's inheritance.

If no solicitor has been appointed by you to handle probate in Greece could you please advise me by fax urgently.

If I don't receive a response today I will have to assume you do not intend to submit probate documents (i.e. the Will) to Greece, and I will need to advise the Probate Registrar to assist in my putting in place the necessary steps required to protect my inheritance.

Also note that there is something going on in Lachania with regard to one of the properties.

Treloar & Treloar  
Re Erini Stiliano estate

I have been advised by the Probate Registrar that I need to confirm with Treloar & Treloar, the Executor's solicitor, that it is ok to issue an exemplification probate document to me for the purpose of submitting it to Greece.

As I have not heard from the Executor or her solicitor I have to assume that probate has not been submitted to Greece. It is 30 Jan 2007 today and probate was granted 25 September 2006 – 4 months ago. Attached is the fax to the Executor requesting the name of the solicitor she has engaged to submit to Greece the certified probate document she presumably possesses.

In five weeks time, the anniversary date of death of my mother, Greece may assume that no Will exists if probate is not submitted by then. A lead time of 4 weeks is required to handle notarisation, apostilling, translation to Greek and posting to a Greek solicitor in Greece.

Treloar & Treloar indicated in their final letter to me on 24 October 2006 that I should seek 'independent legal advice as the sole residuary beneficiary of the estate.'

The advice I have been given is that I need to submit a probate exemplification document, and the Probate Registrar requires Treloar & Treloar to confirm the issuing of it to me.

I would appreciate it very much if this matter were handled immediately by fax or email, so that I may carry out the necessary procedures over the next two weeks.

Dear Vanessa

Following on from our phone conversation yesterday could you please have both Anna Itsines and Gary Stiliano voluntarily renounce themselves as trustees via the Supreme Court, due to their failure to provide any administration or protection of the overseas estate.

When that is done we will look at a reasonable settlement of current estate bills. The amount of the bills can be deducted from the Australian estate and the balance deposited into trust accounts for the grandchildren Sara and Shamona. I already have two Westpac Max-i trust accounts established for them earning high interest. I will top up these accounts with the amount that I owe them - the reasonable estate debts.

At no stage should anyone apart from myself sell any overseas assets to pay for what I consider is essentially the Executors personal debts. **They said countless times, Anna and Gary , that they would consume ALL of the grandchildren's inheritance in their roles as Executors.**

The attempt by the Executors to do just that has landed the Australian estate of \$66,000 worth simple fund deposits with an unacceptably disproportionate debt of \$15-20K, and they have taken **zero** measures to administer and protect the overseas estate for the beneficiaries, which as I divulged to you yesterday is already under threat with a squatter lawsuit claim to be heard in April 2007 in Rhodes.

However, if they *back off completely and renounce trusteeship* now I can be forgiving and accept payment of their fees, up to \$15K maximum.

Note that my daughters have recently joined me to ensure the estate is handled properly as per the Will.

I have forwarded a Centerlink assets statement to the Probate Registrar that proves the overseas assets were indisputably my mother's. That figure in the assists statement was supplied by the Public Trustee and is known to have been the total valuation of all of her 16+ overseas properties plus her Australian Managed Fund assets.
