**Subject:** Erini Stiliano dec. estate - Executors' odd reaction to news of withdrawn Greek squatter lawsuit

I note that the two Executors of Erini's estate, upon hearing of the withdrawn Greek Squatter lawsuit last week, made frantic phone calls to Greece and to your office and to Stella in Adelaide to probe the name of my Greek lawyer who stopped the lawsuit. It was the first time that the 2nd Executor-in-Hiding had decided to make communications with anyone.

I did not expect them to advertise their role in the lawsuit, but could you please confirm that the Executors are ecstatic that the squatter lawsuit has been withdrawn, and that they are not attempting to urge the reluctant 'squatter' accomplice to resume the lawsuit at the Rhodes Court hearing on the 26 April 2007.

I have as a result of my personal efforts saved the property (No 671) and also saved the estate some \$20,000 minimum in legal expenses in Greece.

The circumstances surrounding the acquisition by Executor No 1 of property 624 in 1996, a property worth more than double 671, is currently under investigation by the same lawyer. The primary authentic document signed by Erini **and** her attorney authorising this gift will be sought in Greece.
