SA Government's Probate Mishandling

I use the term SA Government to apply to key officers in the SA administration and judiciary.

I informed the SA Minister for Justice via a detailed fax on 14 Feb 2007 about the conspiracy by certain government officers to undermine my mother's will by the unlawful falsifying of probate assets and the unlawful prevention of my overseas inheritance claim. The SA Minister did not respond to my fax.

On 16 Feb 2007 The SA government subsequently became involved in justifying its unlawful actions by assisting the launching of expensive litigation in order to vindicate its stance that the Probate Registrar had not acted improperly. The Supreme Civil Court action number is 192/2007.

The SA government was embarrassed to discover after the hearing that in his ignorance the Probate Registrar concerned had indeed acted improperly and that the SA government had breached Australian and Greek laws on my inheritance rights, and that the litigation was totally wrongful and totally unnecessary.

The SA government has since been trying, through a series of nonsensical hearings, to manoeuvre itself out of its political mess by excusing the Executors of their perjuries, forgeries and property fraud. This is because the SA government had unwittingly or to some extent knowingly assisted the Executors through the negligence of a SA Crown Solicitor and a SA Probate Registrar.

My affidavit submitted for a Court hearing heard on 23 May 2007 provided a comprehensive account of activities of all parties involved.

I therefore request that the SA Government, through its Minister for Justice or its Premier:

- Cease all hearings in regard to making any unlawful claims against the Greek estate.

- Order that all costs incurred by the Executors and their solicitor be paid by the Executors and their solicitor and not from the estate.
- Order that the SA Public Trustee if appointed confine itself only to the administration of the SA estate only (a \$66,000 managed fund) because the Greek estate is being administered as per Greek law by myself as designated sole beneficiary.

The Supreme Court is unable to issue these orders because the Supreme Court itself, through its negligent Probate Registrar, is responsible for all these blunders and costs.

All the estate costs have been unlawfully incurred as a result of the SA government's probate falsification and withholding submission of probate to Greece whilst the Executors were concurrently conducting squatter property fraud on Greek property. The Executors supported the unnecessary futile litigation as a vital facade to ensure their secret concomitant squatter fraud was not exposed. When I eventually detected and foiled the squatter fraud, and determined the extent of the Executors involvement, the Executors, their solicitor and barrister and the SA government have flipped from a short litigation assault to a prolonged expensive hostile retreat.

It is now a fact that the SA administration has been embarrassed by its unlawful assistance to Executors who have produced affidavits containing perjuries and forgeries, and who have engaged in property fraud masked by wrongful litigation.

Greece has unconditionally backed my mother's will and given my mother and myself total respect and honour, in contrast to the total disrespect and betrayal by the SA government administration.

Does the SA government have any explanation for it's mishandling of a very simple will? I can only think of prejudice and parochialism as emotive administration overriding administration of law and order.

Why after 15 months of maladministration, is the SA administration now seeking court orders to get themselves and the Executors and off the hook without penalty, *after* their expensive covert underhanded illegal attempts at depriving me of my inheritance was foiled by incorruptible Greek Inheritance laws.
